#### ADDITIONAL ITEMS RELATED TO THE MAJOR

- \* The Elementary Spanish 131 and 132 prerequisite must be satisfied by CLEP examination credit, AP credit, or equivalency transfer credit prior to enrollment in Intermediate Spanish I.
- —Courses taken at another university require prior approval from the Spanish program coordinator and the Chair of Communication and Literature.
- —Students taking BIB 111 Genesis in Spanish should not take Genesis in English; credit will not be awarded for both.
- —A 3-hour elective may be satisfied by upgrading the BIB 111 to 3 hours credit with additional requirements, SPA 296 Field Lab, or Special Topics SPA 399A/499A.

# The following guidelines are important. Failure to follow these guidelines may delay graduation.

- 1. Plan schedules carefully. Plan to fulfill prerequisites for future courses.
- 2. Do not alter the sequence of courses without consulting with your academic adviser as not all classes are offered every semester.

- 4. Register for classes early during the registration period to secure classes.
