All items are **due by May 1, 2024** for Fall admission. Selection letters will be mailed no later than June 1, 2024.

The number of students who can be admitted into the Department of Nursing may be limited. Preference will be given to currently enrolled FHU students in good standing.

To be considered for admission to the FHU Nursing program, students must:

- Be accepted for admission to Freed-Hardeman University
- Complete the application for the Nursing program to the Department of Nursing online
- Take the TEAS preadmission entrance test (fee paid by student)
 - Test scheduling guidance available at www.fhu.edu/nursing
- Complete the Essential Functions Document online
- Provide evidence of required immunizations
- Provide a physical completed within the last 6-months. (*Download Nursing Student Physical Examination from the Nursing website*)

Nursing Program Acceptance Criteria

To be accepted into the Nursing program a student must have completed the following courses and the additional selection criteria specified in Selection of Students (below):

- **BIO211 Anatomy & Physiology I (4hr)**
- **BIO212 Anatomy & Physiology II (4hr)**
- **BIO215 Microbiology (4hr)**
- **BIO318 Pathophysiology (3hr)**
- HEA121 Principles of Nutrition (3hrs)
- MAT101 College Algebra (3hr)
- MAT235 Introductory Statistics (3hr)

Selection of Students

Additional requirements have been established to assist in the selection of students for the nursing program. Students must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered for admission to the Nursing program. These requirements are:

- A cumulative GPA of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale.
- A science GPA (BIO211, BIO212, BIO215, BIO318) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
 - No more than one science course may be repeated one time.
 - A withdrawal for other than medical reasons counts as a first attempt in a science course.
 - Must have grade of C or higher in each of the sciences (BIO211, BIO212, BIO215, BIO318).
- A score of *Proficient* or higher AND Science score of 52.1% or greater on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS).
- Less than 12 hours of General Education classes remaining (excluding Bible)
