

Freed-Hardeman University Associates Endowed Scholarship Criteria

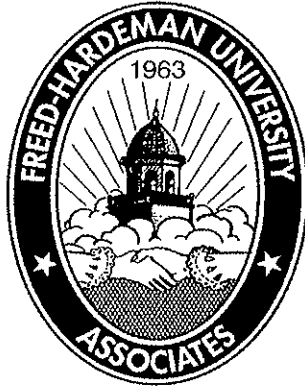
The Freed-Hardeman Associates is a women's organization designed to support and encourage Christian education at Freed-Hardeman University. The above scholarship will be divided between the fall and spring semesters.

To be considered for this scholarship the following criteria must be met. Students will be awarded this scholarship based on merit and need as determined by the Student Financial Services.

1. Accepted as an applicant of Freed-Hardeman University
2. Applicant must be an entering freshman female with a minimum high school GPA of 3.25 and an ACT score of 23 or higher who will be enrolled full-time in the fall semester.
3. Applicant must be a faithful member of the Church of Christ.
4. An application form and all other required documents must be completed and submitted by the April 15th deadline.

Once the scholarship has been awarded the following criteria must be met to keep the award.

1. The student must be enrolled full-time and maintain a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 to be evaluated at the end of each spring semester.
2. Must be willing to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours per school year assisting the Associates.
