

## CARES Act HEERF Reporting Disclosure – October 2021 Quarterly Report

Freed-Hardeman University – Department of Education – CARES Act – Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Section 18004 Reporting Disclosure

As provided by the Department of Education (DOE) as a provision of the CARES Act, Freed-Hardeman University has received funds directly to students to assist them with emergency financial relief related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus. These grants are intended to be used by students for food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and childcare.

Freed-Hardeman University received a total of \$100 from the DOE under this program for this quarter. The DOE has required institutions to award these fund directly to students. The student that was given the \$100 was in our Tier 1 category, which is students that are Pell Grant Eligible. The relief amount was determined by the Department of Education guidelines and are for additional expenses such as eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.
