Applicants whose GPA for at least 90 semester hours is between a 2.75 and a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale may be considered for acceptance under the Alternative Admissions Track Program (AATP)

Students must provide evidence that they have received 90 credits from an accredited institution.

IS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED OR HELPFUL? Yes. One of the two letters of recommendation must come from a licensed chiropractor. Shadowing experience is expected, but the number of hours is not specified.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Logan accepts students at the start of each trimester. Application due dates are:

January Trimester - December 15 May Trimester - April 15 Fall Trimester- August 15

GPA: For each of these subject areas, no grades below a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale may be accepted. In each of the course areas above, if more than one course is taken to fulfill the requirement, the course contents must be unduplicated. In the event an institution's transcript does not combine laboratory and lecture grades for a single course grade, Logan may calculate a weighted average of those grades to establish the grade in that science course.

Students must provide evidence that they have received 90 credits from an accredited institution with a 2.25 on a 4.0 scale.

IS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED OR HELPFUL? Yes. One of the two letters of recommendation must come from a licensed chiropractor. Shadowing experience is expected, but the number of hours is not specified. The remaining letter must be from a college professor.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Palmer accepts students at the start of each fall, winter, & spring trimester. Palmer accepts applications for the D.C. program at any time. However, they recommend you submit your application at least one (1) year prior to your desired term. That's because your start date and financial aid eligibility may be affected by your application submission date.

*Preferred courses include biology, physics, chemistry, biochemistry, organic chemistry, anatomy, and physiology. We prefer that you have an equal distribution of life and physical sciences.

GPA: Only courses with a grade of "C" or higher will be accepted for life and physical sciences and humanities and an overall 3.0 GPA in the 90 hours. If you have an overall GPA between 2.75 and 2.99 and/or fewer than the required hours in the sciences, you may be eligible for the AATP.

IS A DEGREE REQUIRED? ____YES ____NO

Students must provide evidence that they have received 90 credits from an accredited institution with a cumulative GPA of 3.0.

IS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED OR HELPFUL? Yes. Shadowing experience is expected, but the number of hours is not specified. Two letters of recommendation are required, and it is profitable to choose a licensed chiropractor to write one.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: You are advised to submit your application six months to one year in advance of the quarter you would like to enroll. The final deadline to apply is 6 weeks prior to the start of each quarter. International students must apply at least six months in advance of the quarter they would like to attend. Sherman operates on a quarter calendar and enrolls new classes each quarter. The quarters begin in January, April, July and October.
