DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM

Dental Hygiene is a preventative oral health profession whose practitioners are responsible for promoting optimal oral health. Specific professional activities of the dental hygienist include initial screening, examination and charting of each patient's teeth, soft tissues, and other oral structures; removal of calculus and plaque, application of fluoride and dental sealants, etc.
