

















MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Merit scholarships range from \$3,000 to \$11,000 per year. All applicants with a minimum national ACT composite score of 19 (990 SAT: Reading/Writing and Math) and at least a 3.00 high school GPA are automatically considered for this scholarship.

TRUSTEES' SCHOLARSHIPS

The Trustees' Scholarship is \$15,000 per year. All applicants with a minimum national ACT composite score of 30 (1360 SAT; Reading/Writing and Math only) and a 3.00 high school GPA will be automatically considered for this award. National Merit Finalists will receive the Trustees' Scholarship.

FHU PROMISE

The FHU Promise program guarantees that qualified, first-time freshman and transfer students will not have to pay or owe more than \$9,500 their freshman year after all other scholarships, discounts, and grants have been applied. All applicants that have a minimum national ACT composite score of 21 (1060 SAT; Reading/Writing and Math), achieve a 3.0 high school GPA, receive a federal PELL grant award, and be admitted before April 15 for first time freshmen and June 15 for transfers will be automatically considered for this scholarship.

MINISTERS DISCOUNT

The University awards up to a \$5,000 discount to students who are children of full-time Church of Christ pulpit or youth ministers. The Christian Ministers Discount Form must be completed and signed by two elders of the respective congregation. Students are eligible for one discount. Please be mindful of our discount application deadline: April 15 for first-time freshmen and June 15 for transfers.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISCOUNT

The University awards up to a \$5,000 discount annually to any student who graduates from or whose parent is full-time faculty or staff at one of the k-12 schools with membership in the National Christian School Association (NCSA). Any student whose parent(s) is full-time faculty/staff at a participating christian college/university is eligible for up to a \$10,000 discount annually. Students are eligible for one discount. Please be mindful of our discount application deadline: April 15 for first-time freshmen and June 15 for transfers.

The FHU Church Scholarship Match Program will match any scholarship awarded by a church to a first-time student (incoming freshman or transfer student) up to \$2,500 a year. This award is only stackable up to the comprehensive charge.
