GRADUATE BUSINESS – COMMON PROFESSIONAL COMPONENT

The accrediting body for Freed-Hardeman University's MBA program (Accreditation Council of Business Schools and Programs) requires students without a business degree to satisfy a Common Professional Component (CPC) so as to have a background in business. The ten CPC areas listed below represent the prerequisites for courses in the MBA program and must be satisfied prior to enrolling in each corresponding MBA course.

The Director of the M.B.A. program has evaluated all of your transcripts to determine if all CPC requirements have been met. The table below indicates what CPCs have been satisfied and those that have not. Individuals with CPC deficiencies (noted below) will be enrolled in BUS501 each semester until all areas are satisfied.
