Other requirements include:

1. Achieve a grade of "C" or above for each required pre-pharmacy course with an overall GPA for all coursework completed of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale. Approximately a 3.4 average cumulative GPA for students who were admitted last year demonstrates the need for quality. Preference shown to students who have completed additional coursework in natural sciences such as Cell Biology & Molecular Genetics (BIO 333), Genetics (BIO 335), Biochemistry I/II (CHE 331/332), General Physics I/II (PHS 201/202), and/or Immunology (BIO431).

IS A DEGREE REQUIRED? ____ YES X NO

You may apply when you have completed the majority of your pre-pharmacy work and your GPA is competitive. However, approximately 75% of the current students have B.S. degree. Students who have their degrees are generally more competitive.

IS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED OR HELPFUL? IF SO, HOW MANY HOURS?

Shadowing and/or clinical experience is highly recommended, but not required. An exact number of hours have not been specified.

IS AN ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIRED?

The PCAT is NO LONGER required (as of summer/fall 2018). PharmCAS applications are still required.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 1. The earlier you apply, the better.

IS AN ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIRED?

The PCAT is now an optional part of the HCOP admissions process. While the test is optional, applicants who wish to bolster their other academic credentials with their PCAT scores can choose to do so and request that their PCAT scores be submitted to PharmCAS (school code 104). Applicants may also submit their scores for the MCAT, DAT, OAT or GRE for consideration, as long as the test has been taken within five years of the date of application to HCOP.

GPA REQUIRED: Minimum 2.5 out of 4.0 in prepharmacy coursework is mandatory. Students need at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale to be competitive.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications open around June 1. The earlier you apply, the better. Deadline March 1.

1. No more than 6 hours of CLEP credit will be accepted. AP credit will be accepted as long as the undergraduate program will accept it.
2. A grade below a C on any math or science course will not be accepted. An overall GPA for all coursework completed of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale is required.

* No credit toward the 64 semester hour requirement will be accepted for military science or physical education courses.

IS A DEGREE REQUIRED? ____ YES X NO

You may apply when you have completed the 30 hours of your pre-pharmacy work and your GPA is competitive. However, the majority of the current students have B.S. degree. Students who have their degrees are generally more competitive. Students must have a minimum of 72 semester hours of undergraduate coursework completed prior to enrollment to be eligible for consideration for graduate or professional level Federal Student Loan assistance.

IS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED OR HELPFUL? IF SO, HOW MANY HOURS?

Shadowing and/or clinical experience is highly recommended. An exact number of hours have not been specified. You are strongly encouraged to obtain work experience such as a pharmacy technician.

IS AN ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIRED? None required.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Personal interviews for the next entering class will begin in September. Throughout the duration of the interview process, applicants are accepted to the Doctor of Pharmacy program on a continual basis until the class is full.

Other requirements include:

1. Due to the ever-increasing presence & reliance upon computers as tools in the delivery of healthcare, it is expected that applicants possess and demonstrate the skills & ability to use computers in the academic setting.
2. Achieve a C or higher in all pre-pharmacy coursework or above for each required pre-pharmacy course with an overall GPA for all coursework completed of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale. There is no longer a minimum GPA requirement. However, a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher is preferred.

Recommended: Many students benefit from additional study in the biological sciences & chemistry. Recommended courses include anatomy & physiology, microbiology, genetics, embryology, immunology, molecular biology, biochemistry, analytical chemistry & instrumental methods of analysis.

1. Achieve a C or above for each required pre-pharmacy course with an overall GPA for all coursework completed of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale.
2. For all science, calculus or statistics courses, the prospective pharmacy student should take courses which are suitable for science majors intending graduate study and should include laboratories when available. The calculus course(s) should include both differential and integral calculus.
3. One semester of Immunology (BIO431), Biochemistry I (CHE 321), & Genetics (BIO333/335) are recommended to strengthen an application.
