All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of at least “C.” Requirements for the categories listed in written composition, humanities and fine arts, history, social and behavioral sciences, and mathematics will be waived if the student has a bachelor’s degree. All prerequisites must be completed by June 15 prior to the year of entry in the fall.

In addition to academic requirements, candidates are expected to have animal experience and to have worked with a veterinarian for a minimum of 250 hours.

AVERAGE GPA OF LAST ENTERING CLASS:

3.61 overall. Minimum cumulative GPA for residents 2.5 & nonresidents need a 3.0 to receive an interview.

RESIDENCY: Auburn gives priority to Alabama residents. Auburn contracts with Kentucky for 34 positions. Auburn does not offer positions to international students.

REQUIRED ENTRANCE EXAM: Altus Suite

The GRE is no longer required for admission. However, the Altus suite including CASper and Snapshot are required.

*Same course(s) cannot be used to fulfill basic math, biological or physical science requirements and be used to fulfill an advanced science electives requirement. Departmental science-based junior, senior and graduate level courses may also be used to meet the advanced science electives.

Each applicant is expected to have veterinary work experience, although a specific number of hours is not specified. It is recommended to have at minimum 500 hours of experiences in a variety of veterinary areas.
